#### From the manse...

We are currently in the Lent season. At 10.30 service during Lent, as in past years, we are having a preaching series led by preachers from Trinity. The series is based on the Methodist Church <u>Bible month</u> resource on the book of Revelation, the last book of the Bible. This book is unique as it is the only apocalyptic and prophetic book in the New Testament. It may seem challenging to understand due to its visions, symbols, and allegories. Certainly, it may not be possible to decode it completely to give us an easy understanding in this short time of four services, but it will provide us with the opportunity to explore its main message.

The preaching series schedule is as follows:

- March 3: The Church Then and Now (Revelation 1-3) led by Roger Owers
- March 10 (Mothering Sunday): The Triumph of the Lamb (Revelation 4-5) led by Peter Baker
- March 17: Witness, Worship, and Waiting (Revelation 10-13) led by Seungwook Jung
- March 24: Heading Home (Revelation 17-22) led by Catherine Roots

# Talking about Trinity 2 29 June 2024

In the recent past the congregation at Trinity has thought in depth about its mission and outreach, first in order to develop the aims and objectives of the Trinity Towards Tomorrow programme and more recently in June 2023 at Talking about Trinity. Many of the actions suggested at that meeting have come to fruition. However the generous legacy from Alan Scott gives us the opportunity to think about how we take forward our mission in Leighton Buzzard without the financial limitations which have restricted our thinking in the past.

The Leadership Team has met with Angela Brydon, District Mission Enabler, who directed us to the Methodist Church resource "Our Church's Future Story". This suggests churches carry out a Community Audit to better understand the local community which they serve. Leadership Team are now working to compile what we already know, and to understand how we learn more about our local community. We are pleased to say that Angela has agreed to come to Trinity to lead "Talking about Trinity 2" where we will consider how we move forward.

All members and adherents are invited to take part in this meeting with Angela which will be held on **Saturday 29 June**, **10am –2.30pm**.

To support your thinking there will be two opportunities before the event to examine the findings of the audit and to pray for discernment. Prayer stations will be set up in the church on Tuesday 4 June (after Tuesday worship) and Saturday 8 June (time to be confirmed). You are invited to come and examine the information, pray and put forward your thoughts and ideas.
