One such hymn writer was the Rev Henry Alford. His life was touched by tragedy. His mother died when he was born, and he lost his own two little boys when they were very young. But Rev Alford thanked God every day for all the blessings he had. The love of his wife, the joy of his home and the beauty of the world around him

One autumn day in 1957 while out walking, Rev Alford felt a great thankfulness in his heart for the beautiful countryside. When he got home he wrote a hymn which is still sung around the world today.

"Come ye thankful people, come! All is safely gathered in ere the winter storms begin, Come to God's own temple, Come Raise the song of harvest home!"



Revising The Methodist Worship Book

In July the Methodist Conference voted to revise the Church's authorised liturgies. The first stage of the process is to consider the style and language to be used in the resources, in order to enable the Church's worship to be as inclusive as possible. The Conference voted to adopt the principle that authorised liturgy is defined as that which has been authorised by the Conference, rather than that which is contained in a particular book. All resources are expected to be made available online in formats appropriate to their use, for example PowerPoint presentations, Word documents and ready-to-print PDFs. Rather than produce a single book containing everything, it is intended that booklet versions be produced that contain liturgies for different uses. Details will be taken to Conference in 2026 and if adopted it is expected that the first new liturgies will be brought to conference in 2028 and authorised in 2030.
