As usual we made a good collection of food for the Helpers Foodbank at our Harvest Festival plus lots of tools and equipment for Work Aid. At the Harvest Tea even more donations for Work Aid appeared and we were able to take a load to Chesham the next day, where we found a substantial shop area has been developed in addition to the longstanding warehouse and workshop areas. For anyone wanting to purchase rather than donate tools or textile related materials and equipment, it



makes sense to go and buy from Work Aid, so that they have funds to cover the cost of sending container loads to African countries.

Closer to home we have continued to build up stocks of household goods, crockery etc in our recycling cupboard to the extent that we can't take much more. However, when Chris Berry next comes to preach on 28 October he will no doubt take away a good load and create some space for us.

JPIT continue to provide inspiration for us in their monthly newsletter. Two of their staff are planning to come to our 10.30 service on 30 November to present our certificate of registration in the Constituency Action Network. In the meantime Sue and I plan to attend the annual JPIT conference in Derby which coincides, unfortunately, with our next fund-raising event for Marie Curie - a Soup and a Roll Lunch on Saturday 8 November. Unfortunately our MP, Alex Mayer has prior commitments on both dates, but she has expressed her regrets in effusive terms in a message which can be seen on the Community Action notice board.
