Doves of Peace - the South Bedfordshire Craftivists group

On Sunday 2 November the 'Tent of Hope' will be being used as part of the 10.30am service. This was created by the South Bedfordshire Circuit Craftivists group. We are a group of people engaged in using our craft skills to help work towards social justice. Craftivism is a gentle form of activism designed to create positive change.

We have now just completed a further project.

We have created a series of 4 pictures that depict a war zone area entitled from 'Devastation to Hope'. Each picture shows the Dove of peace ever present as a sign of hope at all times.

Our aim is to promote the stopping of wars and urge for peace at a time when war seems to be filling the news headlines. We wish to encourage those with power and authority to change things and act for the better of all.

We now plan to produce postcards of the 4 pictures together and send them to MP's and Arms manufacturers as a protest against war. These original pictures will be used as part of our 9.15 Remembrance Sunday service at Early Church on 9th November that I am taking and will then be left in the hall for you to see at coffee after the 10.30 service.
