

The Gospel of John

'I have made you known to them, and will continue to make you known in order that the love you have for me may be in them, and that I myself may be in them' (John 17;26)

These are words from a prayer just before Jesus entered the garden where he was betrayed and arrested.

Those words encapsulate much of what St Johns Gospel is all about. Jesus comes before God and prays for the people who have seen and will come to know who he is. Above all he prays that they will know of Gods love for all people.

St Johns Gospel is different to the other three gospels. It does not use the same stories of Jesus. Its teaching is much more focussed and complete in its purpose. However it is not just a theological work, it is a gospel alive with characters; the woman at the well, Nicodemus, Martha and Mary, Mary Magdalene who mistook Jesus for the gardener, doubting Thomas and Peter who meets the risen Christ on the shore of Galilee.

Here is a book to inspire us, a book to study and get us thinking. It is a book to come to again and again. For John has written that the gospel is here ...

'that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God and that by believing you may have life in his name' (John 20; 31)

Over the next weeks preachers will be looking at different aspects of this Gospel.

Doves of Peace – South Beds Craftists Group

Thank you to all those people who have sent the 'Doves of Peace' postcards to their MP. I am also grateful to those who have told me they have heard back from their MP. It is good to know that words are being put into action.

I thought I would share with you what has been happening with regards to the canvases since you saw them at Trinity in November last year. As a group we Craftivists have been really excited as the Doves of Peace project is really taking off.

The large canvases have been to Trinity, High Town and the Circuit Service last Advent in Harlington, as well as at a Churches Together ecumenical service at Edlesborough and a meeting with Laura Kyrke-Smith, MP. The accompanying postcards are being used as prayer cards and sent to MPs. Guidelines for writing also appear on the Circuit website, and further postcards are still available from group members.

The Doves have featured in an international art magazine which can be viewed via links on the Circuit website and about which was said: *"Among the numerous exceptional entries we received, your work truly stood out, captivating our curatorial and editorial team with its remarkable artistic vision."*

A recent appearance in Methodist News and on the website of the Methodist Church in Britain has led to requests for wider use. They are planned to be on view at a pan-European Peace Conference later this year, both presbyterial and representative synods in the Beds, Essex and Herts District and at the Wesley Day weekend of celebrations at Wesley's Chapel.
